## Additional Giving Options for the 2009 United Way of the Greater Triangle Campaign

---

The **Additional Giving Options** List “expands” the options of contributors for the annual United Way of the Greater Triangle. The program provides donors the opportunity to review a list of local non-profit organizations, which are not **United Way Partner Agencies** for the purpose of making designated gifts to specific agencies.

### *Which organizations may be listed?*

For the convenience of donors, United Way of the Greater Triangle provides a list (called **Additional Giving Options**) of non-partner agencies with designation code numbers. **This list is posted on United Way of the Greater Triangle’s website ([www.unitedwaytriangle.org](http://www.unitedwaytriangle.org)) from June through December.** The list is not printed in United Way’s pledge form; however the link to the website is printed.

Note: Any non-profit agency may receive donations specified by contributors. It is not required that the selected charity be on any list. A donor may write in the name of the recipient organization on the pledge form – with or without the 4 digit designation code.

### *What are the requirements for agencies?*

The organization . . .

1. Is currently classified as a 501(c) 3 organization by the IRS.
2. Provides services in Durham, Orange, or Wake counties.
3. Agrees to refrain from self-promotion for the purpose of United Way of the Greater Triangle designations. Agrees to refrain from any new organized workplace employee solicitation.
4. Agrees to United Way of the Greater Triangle’s \$50 minimum designation policy.
5. Remits a non-refundable application fee of \$75 and agrees to United Way of the Greater Triangle’s administration charge.
6. Cannot be listed if its mission is as a political action group.

### *How does an agency apply to be listed?*

To be included on the list of **Additional Giving Options**, organizations submit a brief application and agree to the above requirements. Organizations listed as **Additional Giving Options** apply on an annual basis. Applications are available at [www.unitedwaytriangle.org](http://www.unitedwaytriangle.org) in March and are due back to United Way of the Greater Triangle by May 13, 2009. Payments from designations are paid out quarterly during the calendar year following the completion of the campaign.

### *Please Note*

While it is the intent to provide good customer service to donors who wish to support certain charities, United Way of the Greater Triangle does not endorse and is not accountable for non-partner agencies. It is the responsibility of each donor to obtain assurance that the designated non-partner agency is effective and efficient.

On the other hand, United Way of the Greater Triangle Certified Partner Agencies, which receive allocations from the general fund (undesignated dollars), undergo extensive volunteer scrutiny of their programs and operations. United Way of the Greater Triangle stands behind Partner Agencies and the system of meeting the Triangle’s greatest needs. The list of Partner Agencies is made available to every donor in the annual contributor’s guide and on the website.
