UNITED WAY'S SUCCESS.

At age 18, Stephanie left foster care and ended up living on the streets. There were several trips to jail before Stephanie realized she couldn't turn her life around by herself. Thanks to Urban Ministries of Wake County, Stephanie found help with her immediate food and housing needs.

In the Triangle, about a third of the population is spending 35% or more of their monthly income in rent alone. This is one of the reasons why 12% of adults are living in poverty.

Stephanie's life changed forever when she connected with Haven House, a partner agency that helps youth become independent. She learned important life-skills, enrolled in job training and found a new apartment. Stephanie has now become a powerful advocate for other teens facing homelessness.
