PATHWAYS TO PROGRESS: THE TWO-GENERATIONAL MODEL

- **Family Well-Being:** We connect families to the services and support they need to rebuild their lives, increase their incomes, and maintain stable housing to break the cycle of poverty for adults and their children.
- **Economic Stability:** We help families get into permanent housing with the income needed to sustain it as quickly as possible.
- **Educational Development and Parental Support:** We support school-aged children's academic success, provide tutoring, and partner with Durham Public Schools to ensure children of families in emergency shelter receive appropriate accommodations. We help parents support their children's learning.
