More Than A Roof:

- Targets the holistic needs of the children and families by providing early intervention opportunities and developmental screenings for children ages 0-8.
- Offers families enrollment in job training/employment programs, budgeting and literacy classes.
- Assists families with obtaining and maintaining permanent housing through financial assistance, connection to resources, ongoing case management, and relevant workshops.
- Connects children and families to medical and mental health services, enrichment opportunities, and parenting support.
- Provides tutoring/literacy programming for both adults and children within the school systems; works with the children while adults are participating in programs such as Jobs For Life and within families' homes on an as-needed basis.
