- Minimizes additional trauma for victimized children and non-offending family members through the provision of services that offer high quality responses.
- Assures the well-being of the family through a comprehensive, culturally competent response to allegations of child abuse
- School personnel monitor child's academic performance, behavioral and attendance records to provide appropriate services
- Connects families to a shared network of wrap around services to address the many circumstances that may impact their financial situation
